Local resident	25 May	SUMMARY: Proposal for “slow streets” in Saltaire Village I’d like to propose making Caroline street and Titus Street “slow streets” (as an emergency trial) in response to Covid. As you are no doubt all to aware, rat running and speeding is a well-documented issue on caroline and Titus streets. Councillors and officers have been looking at potential solutions for some time, but none have come to fruition. Covid 19 is forcing us to look again at how we use our streets, and it’s clear that we need to make our village centre more appealing to pedestrians and cyclists - especially once schools open again. My proposal is as follows: -make Caroline and Titus Streets “access only” to accommodate cars for residents but to stop dangerous rat-running and speeding through. -install green Planters strategically along the street to Slow any remaining traffic and make it safer for pedestrians -mark a designated cycle lane to run the duration of Caroline and Titus streets - possibly segregated with temporary bollards	Consider the proposal	COVID-19 active travel consultation
